- Week 10 Explain POPAP go through a short text
 - Listening to the Spirit- Pray- 1 Cor. 2:9-14
 - Value underneath it all that we are communicating:
 - Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down observations; questions;
- Week 11 POPAP through Luke 4:1-15

- Application- internal, eternal, external; gospel thread (remember Jesus)
- Value: FIGHT SIN w/ God's Word- Joy in God; Bible saturation
- Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down observations; questions;
- Week 12 POPAP through Luke 4:16-22a (Isaiah 61:1-2)
 - Talk through POPAP
 - Value: Compassion (caring for the poor is part of Christianity)
 - Must explain this simply and clearly; not overstate or replace the gospel
 - Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down internal eternal and external; gospel need and answer
- Week 13 POPAP through Luke 4:16-29
 - Listening to the Spirit
 - Value underneath it all that we are communicating: HARMONY; Gentiles are part of God's plan; John 10:16; Matthew 28:19-20; Romans 11 (rejection of Jews opens wide the door for gospel to Gentiles; Isaiah 42 too light a thing)
 - Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down observations; questions;
- Week 14 POPAP through Luke 4:29-44
 - Jesus and the time is not right; Biblical theology
 - Listening to the Spirit- Pray- 1 Cor. 2
 - Value underneath it all that we are communicating:
 - Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down observations; questions;
- Week 15 POPAP through Luke 5:1-32 (1-11; 27-32)
 - Listening to the Spirit- Pray- 1 Cor. 2
 - Value underneath it all that we are communicating: MULTIPLICATION/INTENTIONAL LIVING- disciples make disciples who can make disciples
 - Who are you discipling and how?
 - Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down observations; questions;

 - Value underneath it all that we are communicating: Loving our enemies COMMUNITY OF GRACE
 - Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down observations; questions;
- Week 20 POPAP through Luke 12:4-21 (focus on 16-21)
 - Listening to the Spirit- Pray- 1 Cor. 2
 - Value underneath it all that we are communicating: RICH towards God- INTENTIONAL LIVING financially; with our lives
 - Homework: read the text before you come- write a possible main idea write down observations; questions;

POPAP

P- Pray

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O- Observations/Questions

Write down any observations or questions that come to mind including other passages that teach similar themes or similar words.

P- Promises

Write down any promises of God that are communicated in the text or relate to the themes of the text you are studying

A- Application

Eternal, Internal, External

These are not just three words but three questions that you ask yourself as

you seek to apply God's word (taken in part from Ed Marcelle at Acts 29 Boot Camp in Raleigh, NC, February 2009). Whether you are leaving a sermon, reading a passage of Scripture or working on a book study, we can ask these three questions to apply Scripture.

1) Eternal: What can you learn about God? 2) Internal: What is God teaching you about your heart? 3) External: What (and with whom) can I share with others?

The thread that ties these three together is the gospel of Jesus.

External: Where can we see and know God's glory the clearest? At the cross (cf. 1 Corinthians 2:1-5). 2) Internal: Where can we get help for our sinful heart? From Jesus, the Savior and substitute for sinners (1 Peter 3:18a). 3) External: What do we need to share with others- either believers or unbelievers? The gospel man - Jesus Christ. The message - Christ perfect yet crucified then raised from dead on the third day, and the gospel's power and benefits (Romans 1:16).

P- Pray these things, this Scripture into your life.

Ex. God make me like this. God turn me from my sin. God help me believe in the power of Jesus I see here. etc.
